# b. Ag Certainty Update

1. Approval of cost share payment for Ag Cert #005 S. Harmes shared Ag Cert File #005 containing bills and invoices for a Septic System, with the Board Members for review. She advised the farmer would use \$8,858.70 of Ag Certainty incentive funds to cover the costs. A motion was made by R. Hall and seconded by C. Krogness to approve the cost share payment of \$8,858.70 for Ag Cert #005. Voting: Yes – 5 (All).

 2. Cancellation of cost share request for Ag Cert #009 Item had been pulled from the agenda.

3. Approval of cost share assistance for Ag Cert #014 S. Harmes shared Ag Cert File #014 regarding a request for \$6,500.00 for cover crops; that Ag Certainty would pay 75% of the \$6,500.00. Board discussion included whether the payment will be for one year, how many acres are included and how the practice will be tracked. S. Jacob moved to approve the payment and C. Krogness seconded the motion. Vote: Yes – 4 R. Hall Abstained. Motion Carried.

 4. Approval of cost share payment for Ag Cert #010 S. Harmes shared Ag Cert File #010 regarding a Grassed Waterway cost of \$597.00, she advised the cost share would be \$447.75. A motion was made by R. Hall and second by R. Wood to approve the cost share payment of \$447.75 for Ag Cert #010. Vote: Yes – 5 (All).

## c. Pollinators Workshop Update

S. Harmes advised the date of the workshop is November 15, 2016; location had not been confirmed.

- S. Jacob asked if cost for event will come out of Whitewater Joint Powers Board's fund, S. Harmes advised that it will not; educational funds are available through Education/Outreach tasks under a grant available through PCA (Pollution Control Agency). The workshop will focus on how farmers can improve management through Integrated Pest Management (IPM) practices that protect pollinators.
