Stewardship Project meeting in Plainview and the presenter, from South Dakota, is a no-till farmer for 20 years and uses cover crops in his operation. His yield is 150 bushel corn in an area that has an average yield of 50 bushel corn. Keeping a mat of vegetation on the ground, keeps soil temperature more constant and improves soil health.
