6. Board Reports and Introductions

<u>Steve Jacob (Winona County Board):</u> The Winona County Board has set the preliminary levy at 4.3%. The county building consolidation process is underway. The County is still involved in two court cases: frac sand and Daley Farm.

Lynn Zabel (Wabasha SWCD Supervisor): No update given.

Richard Hall (Wabasha County Commissioner): Wabasha County is negotiating contracts with the unions.

<u>Josh Elsing (Winona SWCD Supervisor):</u> There is a waiting list for cover crop projects. The SWCD has noticed a trend change from educating the public to the public seeking out information regarding soil health and cover crops.

James Rentz (Olmsted SWCD Supervisor): No update given.

Matt Flynn (Olmsted County Board): The Extension office is being relocated to allow for more space.

7. Board Discussion and Action Items

a. Financial Update - Sheila Harmes

S. Harmes explained the balances for the money market and the checking account.

1. 2018 Audit draft

S. Harmes explained the audit draft, which included the balances. It was similar to the 2017 audit. The WWJPB was in agreement with the audit and S. Harmes will add it to the December Winona County Board meeting for approval.

2. 2019 Audit

The WWJPB discussed audit bids for future years.

b. Lessard – Sams Outdoor Heritage Council (LSOHC) Proposal for North Branch - *Jeff Weiss*Jeff Weiss, Clean Water Hydrologist, DNR Rochester, gave an overview of a proposed stream restoration project for the North Branch near Viola. The project will be funded by the DNR and Lessard – Sams Outdoor Heritage Council and will start in 2020. Restoration work will extend the stream length and construct a floodplain; this will reduce water energy during flood events. The WWJPB discussed stream restoration projects and sediment reduction practices. If needed, the Whitewater Joint Powers Board can provide a letter of support.

c. Whitewater Nitrogen Reduction Grant Update

S. Harmes will have payments for cover crops at the next meeting. She shared a handout from the Nitrogen Management, Soil Health and Cover Crop Field Tour on August 20th. Jake Overgaard is busy with the end of the year test plots for the grant.

d. FY 2020 Clean Water Fund Application Update

1) Whitewater North Fork Sediment Reduction Project

S. Harmes explained the project would address instream sediment and would pair well with Jeff Weiss' project. S. Harmes will find out in December if her application was chosen.

2) Whitewater Drinking Water Protection

S. Harmes explained that Clean Water Funding requires projects and practices directed towards drinking water protection initiatives. She focused on townships with a high number of wells that exceed the water quality standard for nitrates.
