### 6. Board Reports

- Mark Thein Attended a drinking water protection meeting in Lewiston, set up by the MN Dept of Health. The meeting was the first of many civil engagements to collect input on the drinking water plan for the state. The WWJPB discussed the \$50 incentive for the public to attend and the information discussed.
- James Rentz Olmsted SWCD closed out the buffer contract and spent it on surveying equipment. Skip Langer received the 2023 Outstanding Soil and Water Conservation District employee award.
- Ross Greden Winona SWCD is now fully staffed. Discussion ensued about cover crop programs adopted by Olmsted Co, utilizing the ARPA funds.
- Bob Walkes Wabasha County will approve their levy at the next meeting, will be right around 4%.
- Lynn Zabel Attended the MASWCD Convention. Heard a presentation on SWCD staffing; assessments were done and SWCDs in the State are significantly underfunded. The assessment shows that SWCDs need to add 3 to 4 new staff to meet demands of new funding.
- Josh Elsing Winona County levy will be set at 9.4%. He testified at the Capitol subcommittee meeting as an ag expert, regarding the EPA Petition. The new Winona County Jail is done, and discussions continue between the City of Winona and County of Winona regarding a potential shared law enforcement center.
